Scenic Run - Chirk to Llanfair Caereinion Railway Station - 13 April 2025

Ian Theobald (mobile - 07901 670695) has kindly organised our first scenic run of the year, in an area DevaMog has not visited in a good number of years. Starting just outside the border town of Chirk, at Dobbies Garden Centre, we will make our way along the Ceiriog Valley, which provides a myriad of different landscapes including wooded slopes and lush riverside meadows. After driving through the village of Llanarmon DC the road begins to climb as you head towards Llanrhaeadr-ym-Mochnant where the landscape is one of bare mountain summits and heather clad moorland. After passing through Pen Y Garnedd you will continue to drive through unspoilt open countryside until you reach our final destination, Llanfair Caereinion Railway Station, home to the Welshpool & Llanfair Light Railway https://wllr.org.uk. The station has ample free parking and toilets. Bring a picnic along or eat at the Llanfair Station Tearoom which offers a range of hot and cold food, snacks, drinks and ice cream (Ian has promised 'wall to wall' sunshine on the day!).

After lunch return home on a route of your choosing. If you fancy doing something on the way home, Welshpool is only about 15 minutes drive from the station or it's 20 minutes to Powys Castle.

We plan to meet up at Dobbies Garden Centre from 10.30am, where you will find ample parking, a café and toilets. After taking refreshments, we intend leaving




Dobbies around 11.15am to make our way to Llanfair Caereinion Railway Station.
